In the event of there being a debit balance in any of my accounts, for four months after my being called upon to make good the same, I hereby expressly authorise and empower the Hyderabad Race Club to sell any of the horses or my share in any of the horses registered in my name, by public auction and to recover out of the sale proceeds thereof any of the dues to the Hyderabad Race Club.

I further agree to record and declare that if there be a default (after a grace period of four months) in payment of Basic Training Fees to any Trainer holding an "A" Licence with the Hyderabad Race Club due to inadequacy of the funds in my account with the Hyderabad Race Club or due to any other reason whatsoever, I hereby authorise the Hyderabad Race Club to sell any of the horses or my share in any of the horses registered in my name, under his training, by a public auction, and out of the sale proceeds to pay to my Trainer the arrears of the Basic Training Fees.

"EXPLANATORY NOTE WITH REGARD TO THE GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR SALE OF
HORSES BY PUBLIC AUCTION IN THE EVENT OF DEFAULT OF A PAYMENT BY OWNERS"

EXPLANATORY NOTE:

- (i) Since the horse/s or the share of an owner/s in any of the horse/s registered in the name of an owner/s is to be sold by public auction on there being a debit balance in the account of owner/s concerned for four months, after such owner/s has been called upon to make good the same, two such letters by Regd. Post Ack. Due will be sent to such owner/s in advance calling upon him/them to make the payment of his or their dues before the horse/s or owner/s share/s is put up for sale by public auction.
- (ii) Such public auction will be held, as far as possible, only during the Hyderabad Monsoon/Winter Racing season on a race day after the races scheduled for that race day have been run.
- (iii) If any horse/s to be so auctioned does not invite single bid such a horse/s will be re-auctioned after expiry of a fortnight.
- (iv) If at such second auction also, the horse/s does not invite a single bid, the Hyderabad Race Club and/or Trainer would be entitled to give away such a horse/s to a Riding School or to the Biological Evans Ltd., or to any person desiring to use the horse/s as a Hack.

If however, inspite of efforts to find a home for the horse/s concerned, if it does not become possible to do so, the Hyderabad Race Club will again inform the owner/s concerned in writing that such owner/s should remove the said horse/s from the premises of the Club within a fortnight of the date of such letter and also intimate that in the alternative the Hyderabad Race Club will be reluctantly compelled to put down the said horse/s on humanitarian grounds and in any of the aforesaid events the Hyderabad Race Club will not be liable or responsible to the owner/s concerned in any way of manner whatsoever.
